**Stories of Community Impact**

- Amanda opened the meeting with an [article](#) (*Centre Daily Times*, 11/11/12) about one local family's experience with Tides, "a support program for grieving children and the people who love them." Tides is a Centre County United Way Partner Agency, and our fundraising efforts help to support the program.

**Spikes Concession Stand/Group Tickets**

- April reported on her meeting with Spikes staff.
  - In order to staff concession stands, groups must work blocks of games, as opposed to single games. We would have a hard time finding enough volunteers to commit to this schedule.
  - The Spikes promote the opportunity for groups, including special United Way nights, to sit together in the stands. We would purchase 50 tickets, sell them for \$8 each, and profit \$2 from each ticket; however, for each unsold ticket we would be responsible for the full \$8 price. We did not feel it was worth the risk for a small profit.
