FUNDING FROM THE COLLEGE OF THE LIBERAL ARTS:

Liberal Arts Enrichment Funds- The College of the Liberal Arts has modest funds available to assist students participating in embedded programs. Liberal Arts majors seeking financial support for a global experience are encouraged to apply to the Liberal Arts Enrichment Funds Application System: <https://la.psu.edu/current-students/undergraduate-students/scholarships-and-funding/enrichment-funding>

- **Priority Application Deadlines-** Spring Semester: December 1; Summer Semester: May 1; Fall Semester: September 1
- **Eligibility-** Applicants must be undergraduate students and have at least **one major in the College of the Liberal Arts** at University Park or World Campus and be registered as full-time students. Students with only minors in the College of the Liberal Arts are not eligible for this funding. Incomplete applications or applications without thoughtful responses will not receive funding, so students are encouraged to take the necessary time to complete their applications fully. Liberal Arts Departmental Funds- When you submit a Liberal Arts Enrichment Funds application, **the application information will also be shared with your academic department**, in the event they have department-based resources to support your education abroad experience.

FUNDING FROM EDUCATION ABROAD:

Education Abroad Embedded Programs Scholarship- The Penn State Education Abroad Office also offers one scholarship for embedded programs. This \$1,000 scholarship supports Penn State undergraduate students participating in officially recognized faculty-led embedded programs. - **Application Deadlines-** Spring Break Travel: January 15; Summer/Maymester Travel: March 15; Fall/Winter Travel: October 1
- **Eligibility-** All applicants must have a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the Office of Student Aid at Penn State. Your FAFSA must already be on file for the semester of travel. International students are encouraged to apply and, in lieu of the FAFSA form, must complete an [International Student-Special Grant Application](#).
- **Considerations-** The primary factor considered, in consultation with the Office of Student Aid, is the applicant's financial need. Applicants will be notified via email one month *after* the application deadline. Awards will be distributed to the student's account via the Office of the Bursar, and may not be disbursed to a student's account until at least two months after the application deadline
